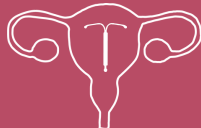

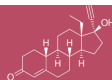
Intrauterine device



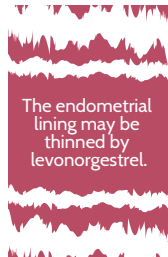
In the United States, Liletta® is approved for contraception for up to 5 years. It is not yet approved for treatment of heavy menstrual bleeding. The purpose of this research study is to evaluate if the Liletta® IUD is a safe and effective treatment for women with heavy menstrual bleeding.

LEVONORGESTREL

Liletta® contains levonorgestrel, a contraceptive hormone used for birth control for more than 40 years.



Over the course of your cycle, your endometrial (uterine) lining builds up. During your period, you shed this lining.



The endometrial lining may be thinned by levonorgestrel.

A thin endometrial lining may result in lighter menstrual flow.
